CHALLENGE GRANT

The North Dakota Challenge Grant Fund Program was established in the 2013-2015 Legislative Session to match private donations on a 1:2 match made to state college foundations. We are excited to announce that since July of 2023 to date we have raised over 3.1M of the 3.4M goal for this biennium. Thank you, thank you! Qualifying projects must be \$25,000 or more in size and designated for student scholarships, program equipment, program enhancements or educational infrastructure. Lower amounts will be accepted on a case-by-case basis. The contribution can be paid as a one-time gift or pledged over five years. Project eligibility must be approved by the grant review committee. You do not need to be a North Dakota resident to take advantage of this wonderful opportunity.
