## NATIONAL GIVING DAY




Save the Date!

## CHALLENGE GRANT

The North Dakota Challenge Grant Fund Program was established in the 2013-2015 Legislative Session to match private donations on a 1:2 match made to state college foundations. We are excited to announce that we have raised our 3.4M goal for this biennium. Thank you, thank you! Qualifying projects must be \$25,000 or more in size and designated for student scholarships, program equipment, program enhancements or educational infrastructure. Lower amounts will be accepted on a case-by-case basis. The contribution can be paid as a one-time gift or pledged over five years. Project eligibility must be approved by the grant review committee. You do not need to be a North Dakota resident to take advantage of this wonderful opportunity. We look forward to our next biennium starting July of 2025.
